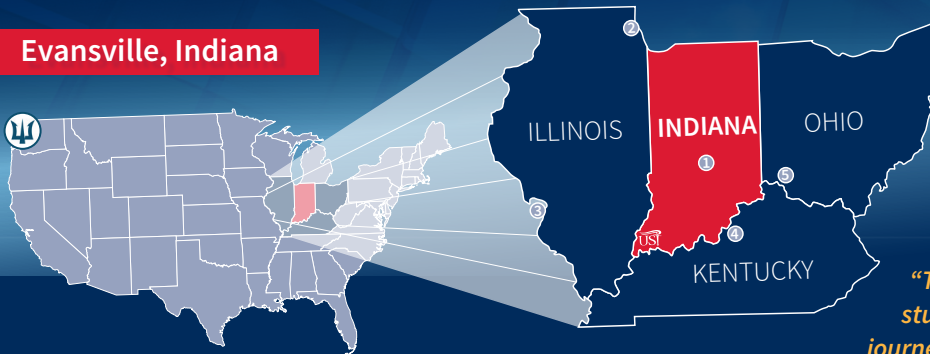
The University of Southern Indiana offers the benefits of a large university, as well as the personal, teaching-centered atmosphere of a small college.

Transferring is Easy

With the Direct Transfer Agreement partnership between Edmonds College and the University of Southern Indiana, you can easily transfer to USI to complete your bachelor's degree.

Two years at Edmonds College = Associate's Degree
+ Two years at the University of Southern Indiana = Bachelor's Degree

- Transfer admission to USI is offered for the fall (August start) and spring terms (January start).
- Simple application process, with a dedicated international staff to help you every step of the way.
- International students are eligible to compete for generous scholarships.

To transfer to USI:

- Request a letter of conditional admission when you enroll at EC (not required).
- Complete associate's degree at EC.
- Earn a 2.0 GPA or higher.*
- Satisfy USI proof of English proficiency; requirement typically met upon completion of associate's degree from EC without any additional testing.

**Admission to some majors may require a secondary admission process with a higher GPA.*

After you transfer:

- Your first two years (half of the bachelor's degree) are complete upon transfer.
- All transfer students must complete an additional six hours of embedded experiences: one diversity course and one global course. Students must have two natural sciences courses, one of which must include a laboratory experience. These courses are determined by a course-to-course comparison with USI's curriculum.
